Mobile Home Owner's Service Checklist

Coahoma Electric Power Association, a member owned cooperative, is pleased to provide electric service to your mobile home. Please read this step by step procedure required to obtain service quickly and safely.

- Retain your Bill of Sale. You will need the Bill of Sale to obtain the necessary permits for your electric service.
- Acquire a county registration number which is required by Mississippi law. To obtain a county registration number contact your local tax assessor's office.
- Any request for service must be handled in person at Coahoma Electric (Engineering Department) to complete necessary paperwork required.
- Your mobile home must be on site before Coahoma Electric can honor a request for electrical service. **Do not site your home before all easements have been approved.**
- Request for meter. A Coahoma Electric representative will set the meter after receiving:

A completed membership application which include social security number, Driver's license or other form of picture ID, and payment of the required membership fee and deposit.
